A 2009 report by the NSPCC showed that 25% of girls and 18% of boys reported some form of physical partner violence. 75% of girls and 50% of boys reported some form of emotional partner violence.

### HOW WE CAN HELP

Safe and Sound is Loudmouth's latest theatre in education programme on safety and respect in teenage relationships. Safe and Sound helps young people aged 12 upwards to think about the quality of the relationships they develop, raises their awareness of the misuse of power and control and safeguard themselves against abusive relationships.

### WHAT WE DO

Safe and Sound includes a drama and interactive workshop and lasts 1 hour and 45 minutes. We are very low tech; we come to your venue and can run sessions in spaces such as classrooms, school halls or youth centres. To ensure the quality of interaction, we work with a maximum of 35 young people in mainstream schools and 20 in non-mainstream schools, colleges, P.R.U.s and informal settings.

Learners will -

- have an increased empathy for people affected by abusive relationships including domestic abuse and teenage partner abuse.
- have an increased ability to assess risk and identify abuses of power and control in relationships.
- have increased knowledge of what local services can do to support young people affected by abusive relationships or domestic abuse i.e. Women's Aid, Brook, ChildLine.

Loudmouth have a strong reputation for looking at safeguarding issues in a sensitive and appropriate way that can help children and young people become more aware of how to stay safe within relationships.
